

Inquiring about the World 171

Presentation and Reflection 35%

Individually create a multimedia presentation (video, power point, etc) to share your topic findings and to review your experiences.

The presentation will contain three parts

- 1) Summary of the Project. Create a short summary of your topic to share the information with your peers and tutor include
 - a. The briefly summarised problem
 - b. The question(s) you investigated
 - c. Your findings
 - d. Your conclusion (what did you find out and how does this relate to your Q)
 - e. Do you feel it was an interesting and worthwhile project to you to the community (why)



For Example if you complete a power point then plan to spend your time as suggested here. The problem (1 slide 1 min), Question(s) (1 slide 1 min), Findings (3 slides 2 mins), Conclusion (1 slide 1 min) Worthwhile (2 slides 1 min)

- 2) Positioning your project into the Australian Curriculum. Using the website links to the Australian Curriculum Science site determine and state where your project links to
 - a. the Science Understanding strand
 - b. the Science Inquiry strand
 - c. the Science as a Human Endeavour
 - d. the History/Geography Curriculum (only if the links are obvious, there are of course other links into literacy and possibly maths and if you can identify these but this is optional)



For Example if you are using a power point then one slide (1 min) for each dot point (a,b,c)

- 3) Identify the 2 Stars and 1 wish for your journey.

These may include your best technology tool (for you as a person or as a teacher), your new knowledge, the struggles you had and the positive points in the experience as well



For Example if you are using a power point then one or 2 slides (2 mins). So a total of 12-15 slides if you create a power point or a 10-12 minute YouTube video.
